You will also be encouraged to participate in the life of the Academy between Council meetings, attending Academy events and acting in an ambassadorial role for the Academy as required.

The roles are unpaid voluntary positions. Reasonable expenses are paid if appropriate. Positions are advertised for a period of three (3) years (the term may be renewed).

Prospective Council members who best meet our requirements may be invited to speak to some of our existing AAC members.
