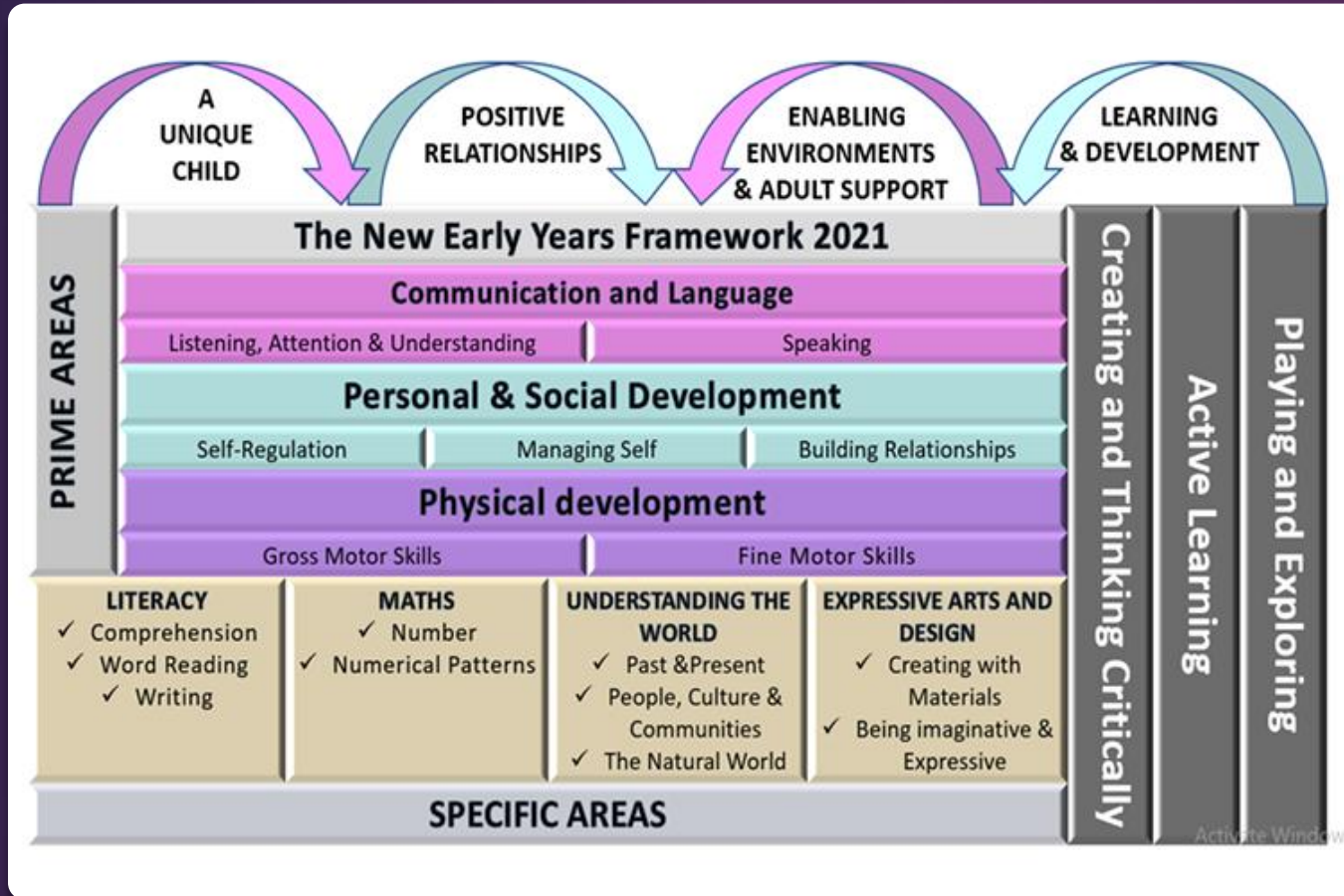

EYFS Framework

Good Level of Development

3 prime areas in addition to Literacy and Mathematics

Communication and Language – Listening attention and Understanding & Speaking

Personal, Social and Emotional Development – Managing self, Self-regulations, Building relationships

Physical development- Gross motor skills and fine motor skills

Literacy – comprehension, word reading and Writing

Mathematics – Number and Numerical Pattern

Statutory Baseline

Reception Baseline

- ▶ The reception baseline assessment, or RBA is a short, interactive and practical assessment of your child's early literacy, communication, language and mathematics skills when they begin in school. It will be undertaken with your child's class teacher and will measure your child's progress from reception to year 6. The school, the teachers and you, as parents will not be shared and the data will only be accessed by the DFE. The teacher will be able to spend quality 1-1 time with your child, getting to know them and if they need any further support in certain areas. When your child reaches year 6, you will be able to see the progress your child has made throughout their school journey. Pronunciation Phrase - a

Open your mouth wide and make the a sound at the back of your mouth a a



Pronunciation Phrase - t

Open your lips; put the tip of your tongue behind your teeth and press ttt



Pronunciation Phrase - p

Bring your lips together, push them open and say p p
